In January 2023, a five-year graduate survey was mailed to 332 undergraduates who graduated between January 1, 2018 and December 31, 2018. Unfortunately, 45 surveys were undeliverable because the addresses were incorrect and forwarding time had expired, or we did not have a complete address. Of the remaining 287 surveys, 21 (7.3%) were completed and returned. Not everyone answered every question. Survey results to selected questions are contained in the following tables:
